Take the Bangalow/Lismore exit from the Pacific Highway, about 12km south of the Byron Bay exit, or 25km north of Ballina. Bangalow is only a few hundred metres from the turnoff. From Byron Bay, take Bangalow Road out of town in a southerly direction. Take a right turn between the golf course and the rugby ground, follow the road up the hill and enter the village of Bangalow from the east after about 14km. See map here.
