#### **AZ CoDA Voting Entity Contains 3 Intergroups**


- 1. Arizona North Central CoDA Region (ANCoR)




#### **LOOKING BACK**

- Participated in the Fall 2022 & Spring 2023
   Paradise Valley Community College Mental
   Health & Wellness Information Fair
- As of July 2023, ANCoR has 54 active registered meetings. Meetings are a combination of in-person, hybrid, and zoom only.
- Separated Events Committee into Local Live and Zoom Committees.
- Local Live hosts approximately 1 Workshop per month on a variety of topics and recovery activities which average 60-70 participants
- Hosts weekly speaker series workshop Zoom meetings which average 40-70 participants
- An Australian member joined a zoom group, then made a trip to Phoenix and attended the meeting in person for 2 weeks.

Currently just one at Cottonwood Behavioral Health.




#### **LOOKING BACK**

- Twice a year we provide counselors and behavioral health institutions with pamphlets and meeting lists for the professionals and their lobbies. Many newcomers say their therapists recommended CoDA.
- Put on numerous workshops and speaker events, sometimes asking members from Phoenix to come and speak. Most of them had potlucks and were well attended.
- We have a total of seven meetings: five in person, one hybrid, and one Spanish on Zoom.
- One meeting, started from a hybrid meeting became Precious & Free International, which has members from various countries and the US, which is going strong.
