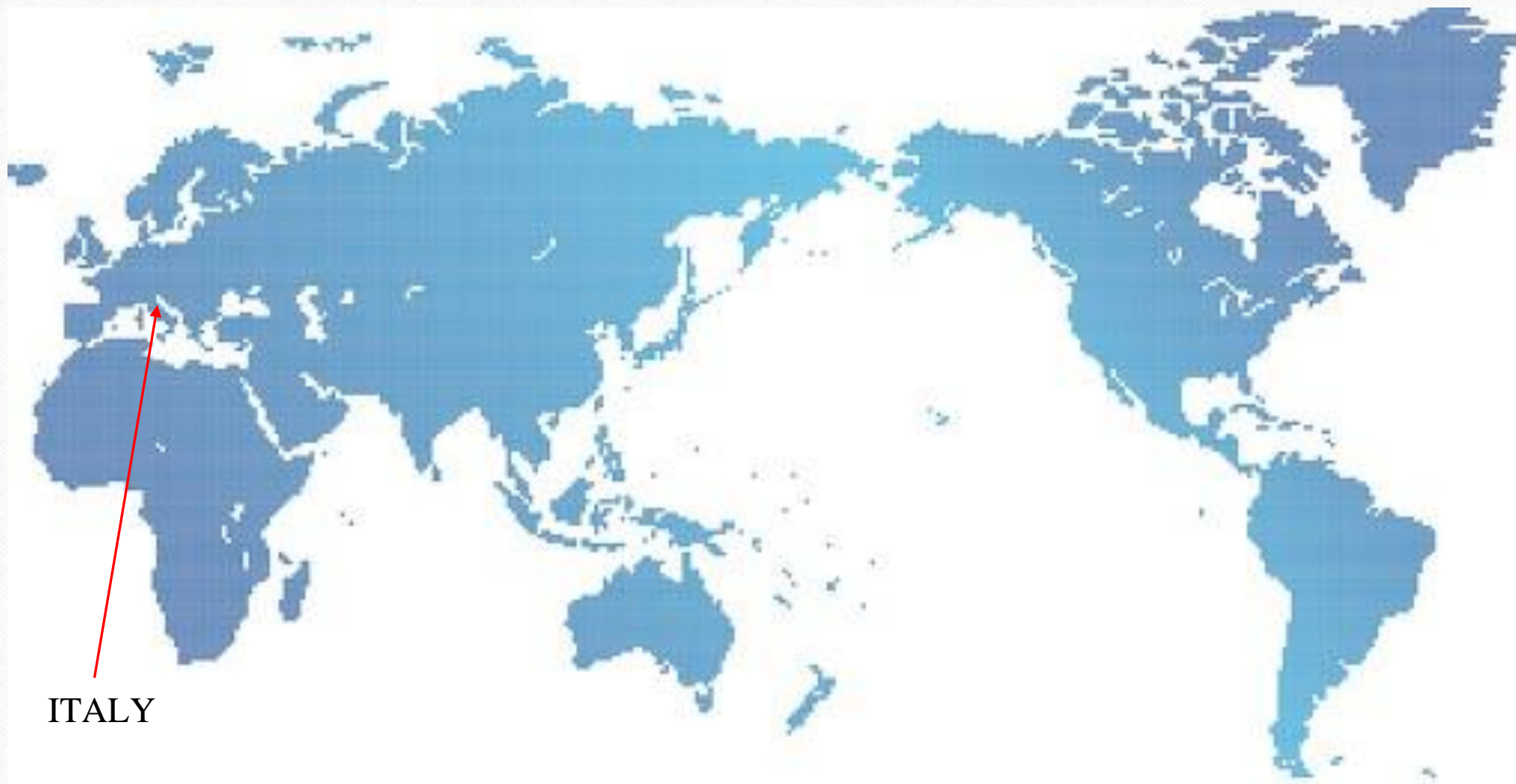

History of CoDA Italy

The first meeting of a CoDA group in Italy was held in Rome in 1992.

In 1993 an article in "Anna", a lady's magazine, made known for the first time the existence of self-help groups for emotional addictions. CoDA starts organizing the first meeting in 1999 in Prato (Tuscany).

In 2004 the legal constitution of the Association and in 2005 the legal Statute was registered.

The history of CoDA, as we have experienced it in Italy, is essentially the history of the awareness and development of one's identity, as an Association and as a Program.

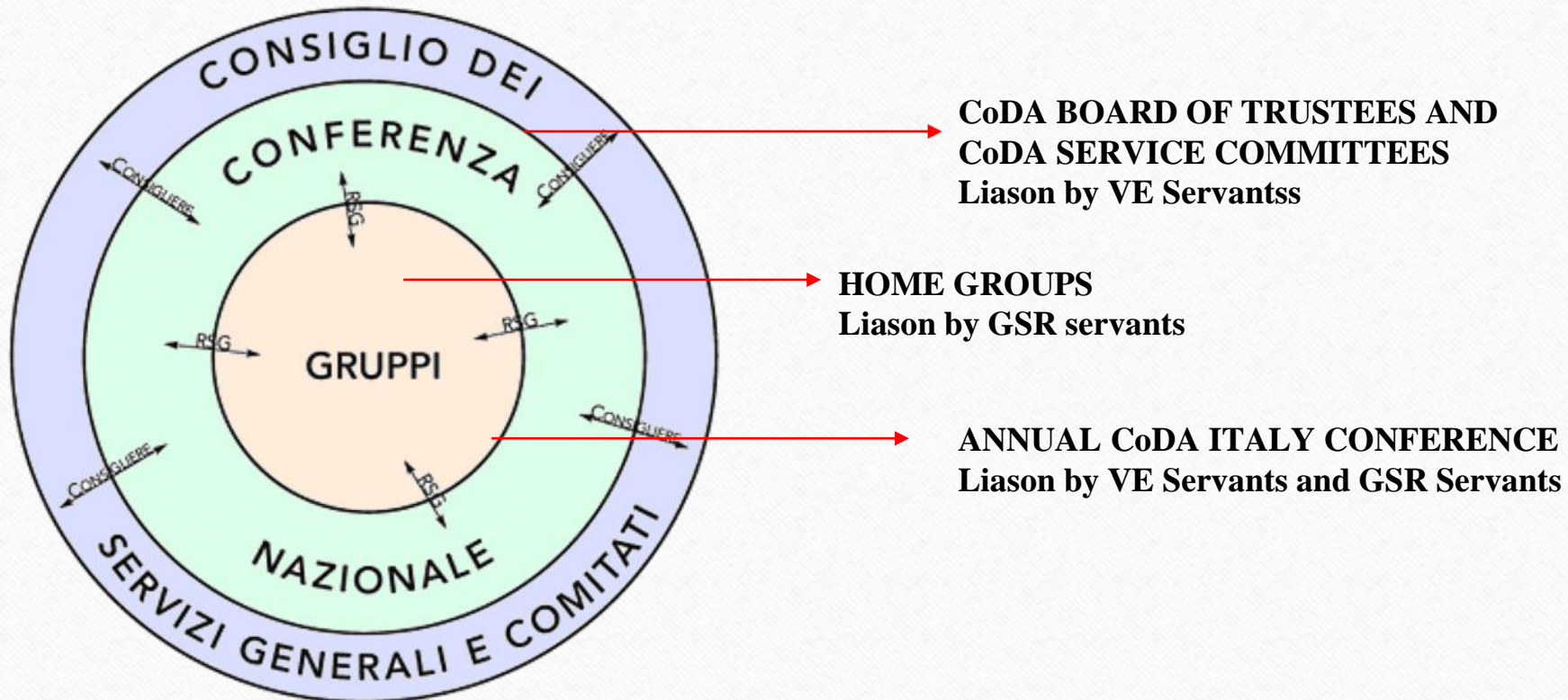
It was necessary to focus on the importance of the Third Tradition, which excludes any "filter" to decide who can be a member of the CoDA: "The only requirement for being a CoDA member is the desire to have healthy and satisfying relationships with oneself and with others".

Many of us came to CoDA from other fellowships because they recognized their addiction to unhealthy relationships, and that it was the cause of the problems that were devastating their lives and which required an urgent and incisive intervention.

A particular effort was directed to the translation of the CoDA literature approved by the US general services (Blue Book, Workbook, Booklets on Steps and Traditions, leaflets).

CoDA hopes to make its work on the Program ever more incisive and to transmit the message in an ever more effective and widespread manner to all those who suffer from dysfunctional relationships.
