Application Questions:

- 1. I understand that the integrity of the Fellowship is dependent on following the Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions. While the Twelve Steps are important for our own personal recovery, the Twelve Traditions are what guides us in our meetings and service work. CoDA's service structure consists of VE's, committees and boards all bound by the by-laws and decisions voted in at CSC. The Fellowship Service manual stands as a reference to guide us during our CoDA service work.
- 2. I'd like to serve the Fellowship as an Alternate Trustee. The board is currently light on attendance and heavy on workload. It is my intention to use my knowledge of the program, employment skills and love for service work to assist the Board of Trustees. Since I haven't any Board experience, I am applying to be an alternate.
- 3. I just celebrated my 10th year CoDA anniversary. My service positions on a group level have been Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Contact person, Treasurer, Literature person, and Alternate GSR. I've been doing committee work for the last 3 years. I have served on the H&I committee and am currently on both the Outreach and Finance committees.
- 4. I believe that my degree in Business Management and work history as a clerical assistant will aide me in providing services that the Board my need.
- 5. (A) I'm the Georgia delegate for CSC 2021 and 2022.
 - (B) When you have the courage to express yourself, you grow as a person. Listening to others allows them an opportunity to express themselves, inform you of things and allows the 2 to achieve a common goal.
 - (C) We are bound by the Traditions, by-laws and group conscious process. In my experience, we refer to all 3 in decision making.
